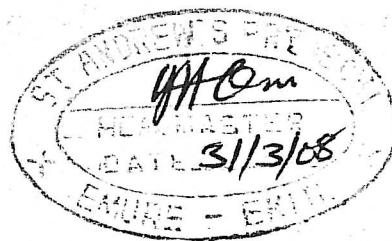

The School lacks buildings because the roofs are termite eaten and partly blown off. The old mud walls are cracked and have fallen down in some parts. We therefore need fifteen-room buildings to be utilized as follows:

KG/NUR SECTION

1. Accommodation 3 rooms
2. Suitable furniture for KG/Nur
3. Recreation materials e.g swing, slide, e.t.c
4. Health / Rest material like mats, foams, towels, e.t.c.

PRIMARY SECTION

1. Accommodation 9 rooms
2. Suitable Furniture for students

OFFICE SECTION

1. Accommodation 2 rooms
2. Suitable Furniture for staff and reception of visitors

SPORT SECTOIN

1. Sport Room 1 room
2. Table tennis board and equipment

ORIJIA JUNIOR AND SENIOR SCHOOLS
EMURE – EKITI
PROBLEM AREAS OF THE SCHOOLS


1. **Preamble :** Orija Junior and Senior High Schools are babies of the defunct Orija High school which was founded in 1980

These two schools shared the personnel, infrastructures and equipment of the defunct Orija High School.

The following are the problem areas of the two Schools which need urgent attention:

1. **The Uncompleted PTA Building:-** This is a four – classroom plus administrative block of 135ft by 31ft which was put up by the PTA since 1982. The building got to roofing stage when it was abandoned.
2. **Dilapidated Classrooms:** The classrooms are dilapidated - roofs are leaking, no doors, no windows, no asbestos.
3. **Administrative Offices:-** The senior school has no Principal's office at all.
4. **Teachers Staff Rooms:** The staff rooms are not conducive - no shutters, no doors.
5. **Staff Furniture:** These are grossly inadequate and insufficient
6. **Science Laboratories:** There are no furniture in the science laboratories. The science equipment and chemicals are obsolete.
7. **Sports:** The schools lack the basic sports equipment.
8. **Toilet Facilities:** These are not sufficient for the two schools.
9. **Water Supply:** There is only one well in the schools. The school can accommodate bore-holes- the water table is not far below.
10. **Computer Supply:** There is only one computer set in the senior school. The junior school has no computer to help the students in their computer lessons.
11. **School Hall:** This is dilapidated - the roof is leaking no shutters and doors and no asbestos
12. **School Fence:** There is no school fence at all.

ARIYASI, EMURE - EKITI.

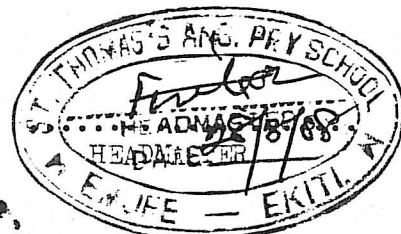
The staff and pupils of the above named school thanked Kabiyesi and the Chiefs for their visitation yesterday 27/3/06. We are now forwarding our request to you sir.

1. CONSTRUCTION: Kabiyesi, as you have seen it, the school needs a complete construction of at least a block of six classrooms. This is to enhance good learning process.
Despite the fact that our population keep rising everyday.
2. RENOVATION: The school being the oldest school in Emure has been marginalised in the area of project sharing. They should please come to our aid and help us there. Pupils are learning under a terrible condition which can affect them negatively.
3. CLASSROOM: The little classrooms we are managing has been destroyed by the termites and the asbestors are no more in good order and very dangerous to the pupils. The one we are using is dilapidated.
4. BUILDING: Two of the buildings which are supposed to be used by the pupils are already down off by the storm and collapsed.
5. TOILET & URINAL: We don't have toilet and urinal in the school, instead we go inside the bush before we can pass body waste.
6. FURNITURE: There are no good and enough furnitures for both teachers and pupils to set comfortably in the classroom.
7. EROSION: The paths leading to the school had been damaged by erosion and this needs urgent attention so that it may not affect the building and give more damage and to the school as a whole. Even drainage can be done to check the erosion.
8. HEADMASTER'S OFFICE: The Headmaster's office is not good, it is as if there is no office because it is dilapidated.

All the existing old building is dilapidating and the construction or renovation is urgently paramount.

We are eagerly looking forward to your pleasing response.

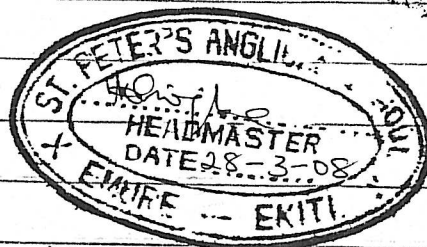

PROBLEMS AND THE NEEDS OF THE SCHOOL

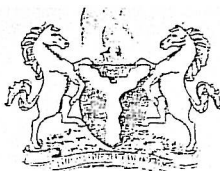
Name of School: Sacred Heart Primary School

MOBILIZATION AND FLAG OFF OF THE SCHOOL ASSISTANCE PROJECT AT THE COMMUNITY LEVEL

The poor state of infrastructural facilities in Ekiti schools should be a source of serious concern to all true sons and daughters of Ekiti. The present administration in Ekiti State is seriously determined to improve the existing infrastructural facilities in our schools. It is in the avowed aim of achieving this that the State Executive Council approved the introduction of the Schools Assistance Project (SAP). Through this, government is inviting private individuals and organizations to donate or renovate a block of three (3) to six (6) classrooms in any school of their choice within their community. It is worthy of note that some notable individuals within the State have responded positively to this laudable project.

2. The State Government intends to bring the programme to all communities in the State with a view to reaching out to large number of participants. This would be done in stages. I am glad to inform your majesty that your town has been included in the list of communities that would participate in the flag off of the project.

3. The flag off of the project in the three Senatorial Districts in the State is scheduled to hold as follows:

- (v) Forwarding the compiled list to the Area Education Office in the Local Government Area on or before Friday 18th January 2008.

- (i) Creating a conducive and enabling environment for our pupils and students to study that would definitely enhance the academic performance of students in your community in both internal and external exams.
- (ii) Improving the educational development of the community.

- (iv) Inclusion of the names of donors in the Ekiti State Honours list.

RE – MOBILIZATION AND FLAG – OFF OF THE SCHOOL ASSISTANCE PROJECT AT THE COMMUNITY LEVEL

Reference to the letter EK/ED/SCHLS/SEC/621/3 to H.R.M THE ELEMURE OF EMURE – EKITI on the above subject matter.

The Primary Schools (29 in number} and 8 Secondary Schools were inspected in Emure Local Government to know their present conditions vis-a-viz the state of facilities present in those Schools.

It was found out that, most of the building was in dilapidated conditions. Library and Laboratories were absent for effective learning environment: Water and Toilet facilities were not found in any of the Schools.

In view of the above, the following rehabilitation is found necessary to be carried out in the schools so as to enhance the Students performance educationally.
